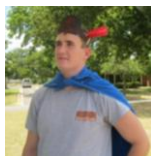

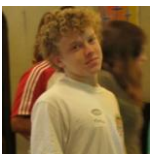

## Fellowship and Spiritual Growth



### Middle School Way Station *Wednesday Nights, 6-7:30*

Every Wednesday night our middle schoolers spend time with the Way (Jesus), our youth leaders, and their friends. It is a positive and encouraging environment to find acceptance and affirmation.



### High School PIT Stop *Sunday Nights, 6:30-8*

Sunday night we meet to catch up with friends, play together, and to worship God. Our student and adult leaders work together to make this an inviting place for new students and encouraging for all.



### High School Small Groups *Wednesday Nights, 6-7:30 & 7:30-9*

We offer two opportunities to meet in small groups discussing God's word and praying for & encouraging each other.



### Confirmation *Sunday Mornings, 9:45-10:45*

Our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students explore the fundamentals of the Christian faith including the Trinity, being a Christian, understanding the Bible and applying it to our lives, church history, our denomination and other religions. At the end of the school year the students make a public profession of faith in Jesus Christ and may become active members of Covenant.



### Sunday School: *Sunday Mornings, 9:45-10:45*

We offer classes for students using Student Life curriculum. Our middle school class rotates each year between The Old Testament and the life of Christ. There is a 4 year rotation in our High School program that covers a variety of topics on Christian living.

## Developing Friendships

We place our youth in positive and encouraging environments where they spend time together in worship, study God's Word, enjoy fellowship and service, and develop solid, supportive relationships with one another.



### Serving Others

We spend time being the hands and feet of Jesus to those in need. We serve with a variety of charities all year long, and during the summer travel to other cities and towns on our annual mission trips.

We offer a variety of activities that help connect students with their peers and our great group of leaders, including game nights, scavenger hunts, movie nights, and much more.

## Adult Leadership

Our adult leaders are a transformative presence in the lives of students to help them experience God, grow in their faith, and reach out to those in need. We work together as a team to plan, pray, and have relationships with our students as they grow together in their faith.
