Policies:

Face Coverings All Children's Ministry staff and volunteers and children who are 3+ will be required to wear face coverings at all times. We will have masks for those who forget.

Air Purifiers We will have air purifiers in the Children's Ministry wing.

Hand Washing/Sanitizing All children and volunteers must wash/sanitize their hands thoroughly before entering any of the classrooms. To aid in this effort, we will have hand sanitizing stations at the door of each classroom.

Physical Distancing Children and volunteers will be expected to practice physical distancing during Children's Church. We will reconfigure our classrooms to accommodate physical distancing, changing the structure of the lessons (i.e. no sharing of craft supplies, no games where children must move to different spaces in the rooms, etc.) and placing floor markings outside the classrooms for children as they enter the classrooms and for parents as they pick up their children.

Cleaning All Children's Ministry spaces, including the bathrooms, classrooms, nursery, will be thoroughly cleaned before and after each service, with special attention given to furniture and high-touch areas. Teachers wipe all surfaces before and after class. Make sure all chairs are wiped down.

Crafts We will be preparing individual craft packets each week for children with supplies and crafts. All shared supplies will be cleaned before and after each service. We ask that children do not bring their own toys or crafts into Children's Worship.

Nursery (6mos-2yo) The nursery will reopen for the 10am service beginning October 18 at 9:45am. Our nursery team will wear masks and sanitize all toys and materials before and after each service.

Children's Church Schedule Children will be dropped off before the 10am service. Children will be picked up following the service.
